PET/CT Cu64 NEUROENDOCRINE IMAGING SCHEDULING NOTES

- 1. Please arrive 30 minutes before your scheduled appointment time.
- 2. Please follow the marked instructions listed below to ensure adequate exam preparation.
- 3. You may take all your medications with a small amount of water.
- 4. Patients should expect the entire process to take 1-2 hours approx.

- Do NOT eat for 4 hours before the exam. Oral hydration is encouraged before the exam and again after exam completion.
- Refrain from physical exercise for 24 hours/min 12 before exam time/date.
- Do not wear any metal items (i.e. underwire bras, belts, zippers, and buttons)
- Please inform us if you might be pregnant or currently breastfeeding.
- You will be called the day before your exam by the radiology department usually in the mid-late afternoon. Please be available to converse with the department during this timeframe.
- If you are claustrophobic, you may need some relaxing medication before your scan. Bring the drug with you on the day of your scan. The tech will inform you when to take the medication.
- For patients on long-acting somatostatin analogs, a wash-out period of 28 days is recommended before imaging. For patients on a short-acting somatostatin analog, a washout period of 2 days is recommended before Imaging.
